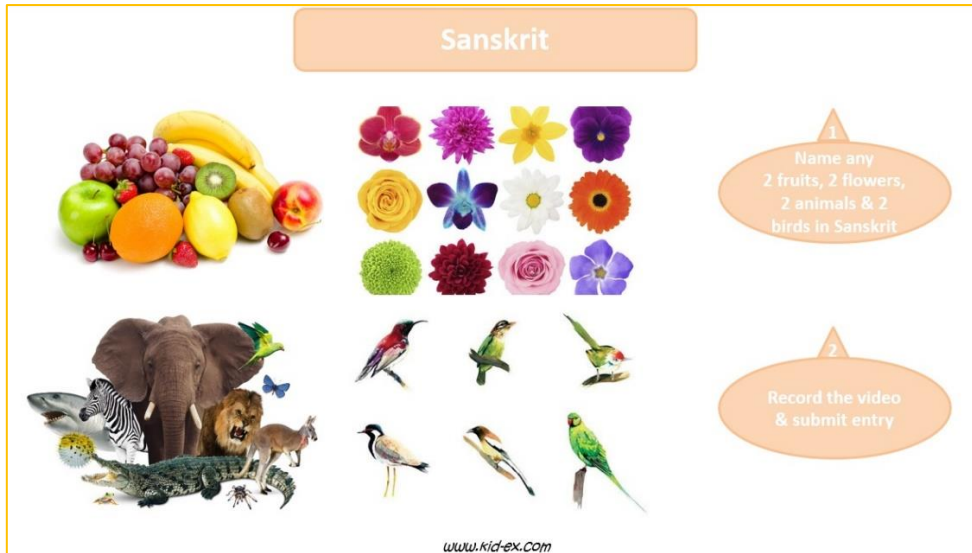

Language & Communication:

Sanskrit

Age: 4 years



Activity description

The child is required to name two fruits, two flowers, two animals & two birds of his/her choice in Sanskrit language with correct pronunciation.

All the words should be narrated from memory by the child & not read from anywhere nor prompted by any another person. All the words should be recorded in one go i.e. no separate recording for each word is allowed. No video editing software use is allowed.

Encourage the child to try the activity as a pastime activity and encourage the child to know more than just 2 fruits, flowers, animals or birds names in Sanskrit.

Whenever you & the child believe that the child is ready, record a video of the child speaking the words in Sanskrit & submit the video.

Assessment guidelines

The total non-bonus points for this activity is 30. Every submission would be rated as either of below.

M = Master (100%)	The child can speak 2 words for each of the 4 categories (fruits, flowers, animals, birds) in Sanskrit with correct pronunciation following all above instructions
The child can speak 2 words for any of the 3 categories (fruits, flowers, animals, birds) in Sanskrit with correct pronunciation following all above instructions	I = Intermediate (80%)
B = Beginner (50%)	The child can speak 2 words for any of the 1 category (fruits, flowers, animals, birds) in Sanskrit with correct pronunciation following all above instructions
For participating in the event & making an event relevant submission which does not meet assessment guidelines for M, I or B.	A = Aspirant (25%)
<u>NA (Not applicable)</u>	No submissions or any submission which is irrelevant for the activity.
<u>50% bonus marks:</u> If the child securing an M can name 3 words for each of the 4 categories in Sanskrit with correct pronunciation following all above instructions
