












Activity description

The child needs to listen to a 4-minute video book on Noisy Farm Animals. The video is available here.

The video shows 7 unique animals/birds.

The child is expected to remember at least 5 animals/birds shown in the video.

After the child has watched the video, record a video of the child naming the 5 unique animals/birds from the video book. You need to submit only the part where the child is mentioning the names of the animals/birds and not where the child is watching the video.

When you feel that the child is ready to record his/her message, record a video of the child sharing his/her views. The child must submit a single, non-edited video for the activity. Once ready, record and submit a video of the child.

Assessment guidelines

The total non-bonus points for this activity are 30. Every submission would be rated as either of below.

M = Master (100%) The child can name 5 animals/birds from the video correctly.

The child can name 3 animals/birds from the video correctly.

I = Intermediate (80%)

B = Beginner (50%) The child can name 1 animal/bird from the video correctly.

For participating in the event & making an event relevant submission which does not meet assessment guidelines for M, I or B.

A = Aspirant (25%)

NA (Not applicable)

No submissions or any submission which is irrelevant for the activity.

50% bonus marks: If the child securing an M can share the correct word/name for the young ones for the 5 animals/birds as well (e.g. Puppy for Dog)



Expert coach speaks

The best way to instil a love for and interest in reading is to simply read to your child. Reading gives you the opportunity for close bonding with your child, and it also provides a window into a world of literacy that your child is about to enter.

A text-rich environment lays the groundwork for reading success. It is not just about having books in the home, although that's a great start. You can also start talking about letters, numbers, and words on packages and signs.



Key benefits of this activity

The activity benefits in many ways:

- Develops early literacy skills
- Gets to know sounds, words & languages
- Child learns to value books and stories
- Sparks imagination
- Stimulates curiosity
- Develops child's brain
- Improves ability to focus, concentration, social skills, and communication skills

Common mistakes to avoid

- Child does not know the word & on asking, does not get his/her query answered leading to lack of interest
- Child is not listening to the story but creating own story looking at the pictures
- Child listened the story but did not understand most of it
