



Language & Communication:
Movie making
Age: 5 years





Activity description

The child is required to suggest changes to a provided short animated movie clip & share reasons for the proposed changes. Watch video in Web Resources section for the exercise.

The changes can be anything related to dress, character, dialogue, scene setting/background etc. The child should also mention the child's reason for wanting to make the change.

The child should point out 4 changes in video and share the reason for change for all 4. Ensure the video is recorded at one go & is not edited/merged. Make sure the child is not reading from anywhere nor is being prompted but is sharing the entire details basis memory.

For submission, the child is required to submit the video file narrating the proposed changes.

Assessment guidelines

The total non-bonus points for this activity is 30. Every submission would be rated as either of below.

M = Master (100%) The child can narrate 4 changes related to the given video along with his/her reasons for change

The child can narrate 3 changes related to the given video along with his/her reasons for change

I = Intermediate (80%)

B = Beginner (50%) The child can narrate 1 change related to the given video along with his/her reason for change

For participating in the event & making an event relevant submission which does not meet assessment guidelines for M, I or B.

A = Aspirant (25%)

NA (Not applicable)

No submissions or any submission which is irrelevant for the activity.

50% bonus marks: If the child securing an M can narrate 5 changes related to the given video along with his/her reasons for change



Expert coach speaks

A screenplay, or script, is a written work by screenwriters for a film, television program, or video game. These screenplays can be original works or adaptations from existing pieces of writing. In them, the movement, actions, expression and dialogues of the characters are also narrated. A screenplay written for television is also known as a teleplay.

The major components are action and dialogue. The action is written in the present tense and is limited to what can be heard or seen by the audience. The dialogue is the words the characters speak, and is written in a center column.



Key benefits of this activity

The activity benefits in many ways:

- Improves storytelling
- Brings structure in thinking
- Reduces verbosity in communication
- Helps understand the impact of pitch & background in effective communication
- Teaches visual presentation

Common mistakes to avoid

Do not suggest a change just for namesake – have a reason behind the same

Do not suggest similar changes – e.g. color of dress of character 1, & character 2
