Activity XII: Record 1 video & submit



Activity description

The child is required to say the sentence "Hello! Pleasure to meet you. How are you doing?" in 10 different languages. The parent is required to record the child doing the activity or the child can record a selfie video as well.

The chosen 10 languages should include any 5 Indian languages (sample list provided as List 1) and 5 Global languages (sample list provided as List 2). The child can refer to the e-manual or write it down in chosen/multiple languages on a paper. The child may play a short video/audio from the web/YouTube to listen to the pronunciation of the words & understand the grammar better. The child should be encouraged to practice the sentence in different languages one by one and ask for help/support wherever needed.

The child should practice this over a few days naturally, and sometimes, with prompting/guidance from parents. When the child is confident that the child can say the sentence in 10 languages at one go, please record video of the child completing its task. Ask the child to call out the language name first & then speak the sentence in that language while recording the video. Do not try to read the sentence from any paper but memorize the lines & speak. Submit the video as an entry for the event.

The video should be submitted as an entry as per submission guidelines.

Evaluation guidelines

The maximum point for this activity is 20. Every entry would be rated as either:

- 1. Master (M): 100% score
 - a. The child can speak the sentences in 10 different languages with correct pronunciation (5 Indian, 5 Global) within 120 seconds
- 2. Intermediate (I): 80% score
 - a. The child can speak the sentences in 10 different languages with correct pronunciation (5 Indian, 5 Global) within 150 seconds
 - b. The child can speak the sentences in 10 different languages with correct pronunciation (any number of Indian or Global) within 120 seconds
 - c. The child can speak the sentences in 8 different languages with correct pronunciation (4 Indian, 4 Global) within 120 seconds
- 3. Beginner (B): 50% score
 - a. The child can speak the sentences in 10 different languages with correct pronunciation (any number of Indian or Global) within 150 seconds
 - b. The child can speak the sentences in 8 different languages with correct pronunciation (4 Indian, 4 Global) within 150 seconds

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- c. The child can speak the sentences in 6 different languages with correct pronunciation (3 Indian, 3 Global) within 120 seconds
- 4. Not applicable (NA): 0% score
 - a. All other submission cases
 - b. No submission

Self-learning manual

Common mistakes child make in this activity are:

- 1. Not starting from sounds. Sounds are the first step to learning a new language.
- 2. Getting discouraged by making mistakes. Practice is the key so find ways to not get bored or lose hope.
- 3. Child is not in the right mindset while learning. They will learn and enjoy the process if they're in a happy mood.

Key coaching tip to excel in this exercise is that encourage the child to listen to Google Translate or Youtube video tutorials which can help with the right pronunciation. Language requires a lot of repetition, a lot of reference experiences. Listening and speaking are much more effective ways to memorize and retain the learned language. Encourage the child to repeatedly pronounce the word and listen to it. It would also be helpful to incorporate the learned word in conversation since contextual memories will help the child remember it better.

Key benefits of this exercise:

- 1. Increases brain power: Learning a new language means your brain has to cope with complexity as it makes sense of and absorbs new patterns.
- 2. Improves memory as it involves learning and recalling it multiple times. Multilingual people have brains that are more exercised and quicker to recall names, directions, facts, and figures.
- 3. Enhances the ability to multi-task
- 4. Your First language improves as learning a new one makes you more conscious of the details of your first language.
- 5. It may help the child in other academic areas. As a result of higher cognitive skills, studies show that the benefits of learning a new language include higher scores on standardized exams in math, reading comprehension and vocabulary.

Submission guidelines

Key guidelines for submission:

- You can record one common video of the child for this activity
- Aim to keep the total video size less than 20 MB
 - Android users can install & use <u>Camera MX player</u> to record smaller size video files
 - Iphone users can change resolution setting by going to Settings -> Camera & selecting lowest resolution from "Record Video" option
- Submit the video on:
 - o KidEx website: Visit here & upload the files following the instructions
