Make the child watch a 50 sec video on toys' organ donation

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Activity description

The child is required to watch a video on the Social Good cause of Organ Donation. S/he is supposed to pay attention to the video and share the gist of the video message in at least 10 sentences. The link of the video can be found [here](#) (also, available in “Useful Web Resources” section below).

The video has an important message to convey. It is advised that the parent/guardian should translate the significance of the visuals for the child and encourage the child to speak confidently about what s/he has learnt from the video. Please watch the video closely with the child and feel free to take screenshots wherever necessary so that the child can later spend time with the still pictures and understand what the picture intends to convey. The child can refer to these pictures during the presentation as well.

Record and submit a video of the child describing what s/he has watched and learned.

Assessment guidelines

The total non-bonus points for this activity is 30. Every submission would be rated as either of below.

M = Master (100%)	The child can speak at least 10 sentences & on topics related to observations from the video or induced interpretations related to organ donation topic
The child can speak at least 7 sentences & on topics related to observations from the video or induced interpretations related to organ donation topic	I = Intermediate (80%)
B = Beginner (50%)	The child can speak at least 5 sentences & on topics related to observations from the video or induced interpretations related to organ donation topic
For participating in the event & making an event relevant submission which does not meet assessment guidelines for M, I or B.	A = Aspirant (25%)
NA (Not applicable)	No submissions or any submission which is irrelevant for the activity.

50% bonus marks: If the child securing an M can speak the 10 sentences in less than 60 seconds without speaking hurriedly.

Expert coach speaks

The progress in medical sciences and advancement of technology have led to novel methods by which death can be transformed into life. By donating an organ, one human gives life to another. It is about realizing the potential of being human. It is about recognizing the nature of inherent vitality that is capable of igniting life in other beings. As humans we must take the responsibility to put this asset to the best use possible.

Organ Donation is at once a scientific, psychological, social, moral, ethical and political issue. The given activity encourages the child to explore the ethical dimension and aims to lay a ground on which other dimensions related to the cause can be explored.



Key benefits of this activity

The activity benefits in many ways:

- Sensitizes the child about the noble cause of Organ Donation
- Promotes enquiry about concerns that matter to humanity at large
- Serves as an example to demonstrate that the most important of concerns can be explained through simple things
- Encourages her/him to take up a social cause and spread awareness about it
- Heightens the Emotional Quotient (EQ) of the child

Common mistakes to avoid

- *Thinking that the child is too young to understand the cause*
- *Not answering questions / curiosity induced in the child*
- *Harbouring apathy for socio-emotional skills activity*
